

In the last 2-week period (Aug 13 - 26), 46 incidents were reported in Beat 204. Of those, one occurred in the area we patrol.

On August 20, 2022, residents in the area of 1809 Defoor Avenue called the police after they saw the well-known vagrant return to the unoccupied placarded house. Officers responded and met with the owner of the house who gave police permission to force entry to find the vagrant trespasser.
